Yesterday, your PCC spent much of the day pouring over the final draft of our re-ordering proposals for the church. A copy of the full **'Re-ordering Plan'** will be on display very soon.

The PCC also spent time thinking about our **Spiritual Development Plan**. It is important that we should press onwards with the important work of improving our buildings for the next generation. But we mustn't lose sight of God's *eternal* mission - in which we share - to keep on encouraging our neighbours to engage with the things of God.


There's some great news to share on the Big Build Campaign: **the campaign has so far raised £105,668 this year**. Thank you to everyone who has been SO generous with time and money! We are using some of these funds to bring about the radical improvements you will see around the Pallant Centre (including central heating to the upper floors, installed last month). But our main focus is on the re-ordering of our North Transept - just as soon as all the relevant permissions can be obtained.

Plans are also well advanced for a public consultation on the **next steps for the Pallant Centre**. A consultation document will be published soon, with plans for radical changes to the centre, for the benefit of the whole community.
