The last word...from Canon Tom
Judge not, lest ye be judged...

Jeremy Corbyn managed to upset some of the more easily-excitabile members of the press this week, when he 'failed' to bow to the Queen at the beginning of the Queen's Speech. Severe invective was poured on him across the media (and especially on social-media). He was branded a 'traitor' as well as many other less printable epithets.

This was despite the fact that the convention is that 'Black Rod' and the Sergeant-At-Arms are the only ones who bow to the Queen - thereby representing the whole of Parliament. In fact, to the delight of some, our Prime Minister was apparently in the wrong, by having bowed her head. How often do we find ourselves criticising or complaining about someone whose life we cannot know, and whose circumstances we can only guess? What judgement do we bring upon ourselves by encouraging such criticism through gossip and slander in our own lives?

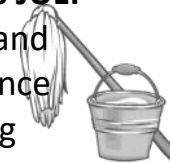
