Sorry - No Parking at the Pallant!

Thanks to the ever-increasing popularity of The Pallant Centre, we have carried out a review of the existing parking requirements and the resources available. The reasons behind this are:

- a considerable increase in usage of the Pallant Centre as a whole
- the requirement and need of user-group facilitators
- a number of 'near misses' likely to lead to harm, serious injury or death

We are aware there have been some flexible arrangements and 'agreements' made over the years. However, it is clear we can no longer sustain these arrangements at the detriment of those running groups, classes and events or to our staff and Pallant Centre volunteers.

Our commitment to the duty of care we have to those groups and people, is ultimately ensuring a safe place to visit and in which to work. Current parking usage and practice does not demonstrate this.

Therefore, we are now advising users of The Pallant Centre car park that:

- a valid permit must be displayed (new permits issued Jan 2018)
- the permit must be for a current activity **at The Pallant Centre**
- visitors, class or session attendees to The Pallant Centre should use alternative parking

Permits will be replaced in January 2018 and will clearly display the name, registration and reason for the permit. Permits should only be used for that purpose.

Anyone carrying out Church duties, but using paid parking facilities elsewhere, can submit a claim with receipts for parking costs via the Parish Office. Many free options are also available locally. Thank you for your understanding.
