Church Accounts.



The **Annual Report and Statement of Financial Activities for the year ended 31st December 2017** will be available before the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) on 29th April in hard-copy and is now on our web-site at

<http://stfaith.com/wp-admin/post.php?ost=12708&action=edit>.

Should you have any questions on the accounts please let *Clive Barnett*, our Treasurer, have them by **22th April** to prepare answers at the APCM.

The terms used in the **Financial Statements** are "**General**", "**Unrestricted**", "**Designated**" and "**Restricted**". All churches have a "**General**" fund which is used to pay all the everyday expenses. The "**General**" fund is "**Unrestricted**" because the money has been given to the church on the general understanding that it will be used at the discretion of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) for furthering the mission and ministry of the church.

The PCC may decide to put some of the "**Unrestricted**" fund money aside in other funds for use in the future, e.g., for future building repairs that may include those noted in the Quinquennial report; or our Big Build Campaign. This money is "**Designated**" for these particular projects for administration purposes only. "**Designated**" funds are still "**Unrestricted**" and can be moved to other "**General**" funds. Money received which has been given for a particular purpose, e.g., for the organ; church lighting; a fund-raising event for the repair of the roof; a donation made, or a legacy left to the church for a particular purpose, are "**Restricted**", and must not be used by the PCC for any other purpose. Another form of "**Restricted**" fund is known as an "**Endowment**" fund. This is either money given to the church with the specific instruction that only the income gained from the money can be spent, or an asset (such as a house) donated to be retained for continuing use by the church.

St. Faith's has four accounts "**CAF Cash Account**", "**COIF Savings Account**", "**CAF Property Development Cash Account**" and "**COIF Property Development Savings Account**". Acronyms you will see in the **Annual Report and Statement of Financial Activities** are: **CAF—Charities Aid Foundation**; **CBF—Central Board of Finance**; **CCLA—Churches, Charities & Local Authorities**; **COIF—Charities Official Investment Fund**.

Security. Visitors to St Faith's appreciate that the church is open every day. It is important however to ensure that the building is kept safe and secure. Stewards are on duty on most weekday mornings but at other times there is often no one around. CCTV has been installed so that any problems can be quickly identified and all moveable items have been '*smart watered*'. This ensures that should anything go missing that it can be easily traced.



Notes of the Parochial Church Council Meeting on Monday 12 February 2018

Spiritual Development Plan. Five small working groups were established to think about growth through: Worship & Prayer; Ministry & Service; Community Activities; Adults; and with Children & Families. PCC members will chair the five groups (with support from the Ministry Team) reporting to a Parish Conference on 18 August.

North Transept & Vestries re-ordering & Plastering Repairs/Repainting. Formal decision on the North Transept work is awaited but permission has been given for the re-plastering and repainting work.

It was agreed unanimously that *Tracey Shepherd* (glass artist) should be commissioned to put forward designs for the inner door of the North transept.

God's Acre. The next stage for the development following the DAC's positive interest, is to obtain pre-planning advice from HBC followed by public consultation. It would be important to involve the local Access Group. Tree works are scheduled to raise the crown of the North West yew tree, raise the crown of the cherry tree and to pollard the 16 limes.

Chairs/Pews Design Brief. This was approved subject to minor changes.

Pallant Consultation. The recommendations were approved to: upgrade hall; build a new Dynamo room in the Courtyard; to develop a hall atrium; to work on the garrett/flat; and to consider solar power.

Clare Kennar's Sabbatical Leave. Following Clare's change of role, this leave would now only be for one month (Australia) and for short trips to Lindisfarne and Iona.

Diocesan Mission Development Fund. It was unanimously agreed to send £500.

Standing Committee Minutes. "*EASYZ fundraising*" scheme. It was felt that further investigation of this was required. It was recognised that Capital Fundraising should be maintained.

Financial Matters. Late completion of 2017 projects is resulting in a deficit for the first month of this year, but there was no need for concern at present provided that there is constant monitoring of expenditure.

Safeguarding/Health and Safety/Data Protection. These tasks will be undertaken by *Pauline West*
