The Havant Homeless Community Trust (HHCT). The HHCT was initiated by Havant



Borough Council (HBC) in 2014 to discuss how the rough sleepers in the Borough could be helped. *Tim Dawes*, together with *Jackie Martin* (secretary and trustee), the *Rev Victoria Morgan*, *Paul Utting* and members of other Havant Churches formed the committee. St Faith's

Church, Havant Borough Council, the Beacon Church and PO9 Publications gave financial support to the Project, together with various private donors. There are very few rough sleepers in Havant this summer but they are itinerant and prefer to find a quiet location to sleep where there is little fear of harassment. Their problems can be complex but HHCT aims to give support wherever possible. Emergency assistance is available to them by way of a tent, sleeping bag, rucksack and a torch together with laundry vouchers and clothes. The United Reformed Church provides a lunch on Saturdays (and at Christmas) and St Faith's is open weekday mornings for a warm drink and biscuits. HBC has a legal requirement to provide emergency bed and breakfast during any cold weather emergency and the Housing department keeps in regular contact with the various agencies in order to provide longer term accommodation at Two Saints Hostel in Portsmouth. Ongoing financial help to the Project is vital and donations to this important work are gratefully accepted. These can be left at St Faith's Parish Office marked 'Havant Homeless Trust'.

Two New Activities Starting this Autumn.

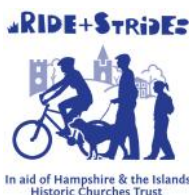
Thursdays at Two (TAT) will be held on the last Thursday of every month and it is for everyone who would like to call in to the Pallant Centre (St Faith's Church Hall). The afternoon will include a short talk on a topic such as crime prevention, the Talking News, etc; in fact anything in which people express an interest. Refreshments will be available as well as recreational games. The aim is for it to be a very flexible time in which everyone who wishes can participate and put forward ideas. The hours for the TAT are from 2pm until 4pm and is run by *Sandra Haggan*.



Little Seeds Play and Stay. The 6th September will be the first session for this group aimed at pre-schoolers and their parents/carers and grandparents. This group will meet on Fridays from 10am until 11.30am in the Pallant Centre where there will be plenty of toys and crafts to play with. Fun singing and other activities are included. Adults are most welcome provided they come with a small child! The group is run by *Sandra Haggan*.



Ride and Stride around the churches this year will be on Saturday 14 September.



This is an ecumenical venture organised by the Hampshire and the Islands Historic Churches Trust. It is well supported by a variety of other denominations including the Roman Catholic, Free Churches and the Society of Friends (Quakers). The sponsorship money collected from the participants is redistributed via grants to churches which have a need for repair and restoration. Last year St Faith's received £1,000 towards the restoration of our Patronal Banner. Riders and Striders demonstrate many ways of travelling from church to church: walking, cycling, using buses as transport, motor cycles, mobility scooters and horseback. It is a very enjoyable day for participants and helpers. St Faith's is well known not only for its warm welcome but also for the delicious cakes provided. It is hoped that this year will be no exception.
