Saints Alive! by Roger Jones

Wagner and St. John the Baptist

"*The Master-Singers of Nuremberg*" is a music drama (or opera) in three acts, written and composed by *Richard Wagner*. It is among the longest operas commonly performed, usually taking around four and a half hours. It was first performed at the *Königliches Hof- und National-Theater*, today the home of the *Bavarian State Opera*, in Munich, on 21 June 1868. It is the Eve of *St. John the Baptist's Day* and after the overture, a church service is just ending with a singing of *Da zu dir der Heiland kam* (When the Saviour came to thee), an impressive pastiche of a *Lutheran* chorale. As Sunday 25th June 2017 is the day after *The Feast of St. John the Baptist*, *Alan Hakim* requested that the chorale be sung by St. Faith's Choir. It appears in The English Hymnal under the section, '*Sacraments and other Rites*', number 313.

Notes of the Parochial Church Council Meeting on 24 April 2017

1. **Floodlights.** Replacements for the roof lights installed with the same light-colour as the ground level lights.
 2. **Electronics Project** is complete with new lights in the vestry and lobby. The bookcase on North wall has been removed. Hymn books to be stored in the vestry.
 3. **Pallant Hall Toilets** - current completion of male and female toilets expected end of May.
 4. **Health and Safety Policy.** Recommendations have been received and will be integrated into the Policy.
 5. **4 North Street – Sue Ryder.** Progress made on the building's maintenance. The lessees have the responsibility for the flat roof.
 6. **Illness of Dave Pearson.** *Dave* thanked everyone for their consideration during his illness. He is home for appointments but working on funding applications.
 7. **The new altar frontal** is in progress
 8. **Organ work** has been completed.
 9. **Fire alarm** to be considered in the bell tower.
 10. **Courtyard of the Pallant Centre.** Work has been carried out. Provision of floodlights in the car parking area to be considered.
 11. **Churchyard:** Working parties have been clearing undergrowth.
 12. **Christingle Service.** 35 people attended in January, but no-one attended the experimental **Easter Service** aimed at families (so is unlikely to be repeated).
 13. **Chairs in the North transept Area.** Replacing them to be investigated.
 14. **Pastoral and Stewarding Team.** *Rosemary Thomas* is standing down from her role as organiser. Her replacement is *Julia Hancock*.
- Financial Matters**
15. In the first quarter of the year there was a surplus of £15,000, due to a slightly higher income than anticipated. Budgeted repairs to the roof and gutters are still expected in the next quarter.
 16. Capital Fundraising (Big Build) £35,000 up to the end of March.
 17. *Canon Tom* explained the Five year plan chart. The Acting Director of The Spring is being very helpful with advice on Arts Centre Grants. The PCC approved the Plan.
 18. **Bell Ringers' Account** - a new arrangement had been approved on the management of this account.
 19. **Electoral Roll** this had been revised. Members now numbered 170.
 20. **Safeguarding:** All DBS forms had been sent to the Diocese. E-learning training was underway.
 21. **The Archery Group** only use the Hall during the winter months. Discussions being held with their committee regarding the loss of revenue to the parish.
 22. **Parties in the Hall.** There had been major problems with some disruptive parties resulting in complaints from neighbours. It was proposed and agreed that in future the hall should only be let out to people known to the parish.
 23. **Defibrillator.** Proposed and agreed by the PCC that it should investigate the provision of a defibrillator for the church and local community.
