### ***Patronal Festival 2017 – 8 October***



16 members of the congregation are putting on a play about St. Faith at the 9.30am Parish Communion Service on 8 October, the nearest Sunday to the Feast of St. Faith, 6 October. Consisting of 8 short scenes, it tells the story of St. Faith's martyrdom in France and the imaginary dedication of this church in her name.

***New Sound System.*** Many years ago, the priest intoned behind the rood screen during church services. Today congregations are fully involved and 'all over sound' is important so that everyone knows what is happening. Recently six new speakers have been placed in the church. A new sound system has replaced the previous one which had faithfully served the church for thirty years or so. This design is aimed primarily to give a clear sound which can be heard in all parts of the building. It is not an instant solution, for over the next few weeks fine tuning will be needed, a feature not present in the old system. It will also be able to be connected up to the proposed projector and screen to make an integrated audio visual system. Exciting developments lie ahead!

### ***Notes of the Parochial Church Council Meeting on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2017***

*Richard Andrews*, Church Architect, was welcomed to the meeting.

**1 Constitutional Matters** It was agreed that *Will Coulston* should in future attend meetings as a non voting staff member following his appointment as Pallant Centre Manager.

**2 Health & Safety Policy** This had already been scrutinised by the Standing Committee and given a green light by the church insurers. Following discussion, the policy was adopted unanimously. No member of the PCC felt able to take on the role of Health & Safety Officer. Until a volunteer comes forward from the congregation, the Church Wardens, supported by the Parish Administrator, would take on this responsibility.

**3 Defibrillator** *Bill Jones* spoke of his findings to date. It was noted that there was no immediate funding for the project and a small group of *Bill Jones, Paul Utting and Sandra Haggan* were tasked to propose a definitive proposal to the PCC.

**4 Curates' Ordination** It was formally noted, that *David and Vickie Morgan* would be ordained at St Faith's on 16<sup>th</sup> September. Arrangements were in hand for the provision of refreshments in the Pallant Centre Hall following the service.

**5 Standing Committee**

\*It was noted that a third floodlight had failed. This had been reported to HBC.

\*The possibility of an Arts Council Bid for the Pallant is being explored.

\*The possibility of renovating the roof and loft of Church House is being explored.

\* There is to be a get-together of the Finance Team on 3<sup>rd</sup> October.

The minutes were approved.

**6 Financial Matters** The Revenue Budget shows a surplus of £18,146. This will underwrite the appointment of the new Pallant Centre Manager and also fund the upgrade of the driveway of 1 Churchfields and the internal needs of 2 Churchfields. The Capital Budget (Big Build Campaign) stands at around £89K— largely thanks to one particular parishioner who has made extremely generous donations. £21.6K has been spent this year on capital improvements, including the new PA system. With £50K set aside on reserve, there is around £98K at disposal for future projects.

**7 Electoral Roll** There has been one change of address noted and one name removed following the death of a church member. There are people on the Roll who no longer attend St Faith's but this will be rectified at the next revision.

**8 Safeguarding** A Safeguarding Training session on working with vulnerable adults will be held on 17<sup>th</sup> August. This is essential training for church volunteers.

**9 Church Re-ordering** A draft consultation document had been circulated to PCC members prior to the meeting. Following an in depth discussion Canon Tom agreed to make some amendments and to circulate the revisions to the PCC. Following their approval, the paper would be available to the congregation to comment on as from Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> August.

**The next PCC meeting is to be held on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017.**
