Peter Elmes. The model of St Faith's which is situated in the South Transept was



built by *Peter Elmes*. He has always been interested in model making but it is only since his retirement fifteen years ago, that he has been able to follow this hobby. He served in the Royal Navy for twelve years where he was an armourer in the submarine and torpedo branch and later as a mechanic in the Weapons and Electrical Branch. Subsequently he worked with Marconi for thirty one years and has now for the past fifteen years,

following his retirement, been free to work with wood which he finds so very satisfying. He has two dolls houses in his bedroom, one a four storey town house and the other a two storey shop and tearoom, which he has made. His wife *Chris* is very understanding! The touch model of St Faith's was made to help visually impaired visitors to understand our building. He feels however the greatest sense of achievement with the scale model of our church building. It is his gift to us. He never thought that this construction would happen and he has taken the greatest care in its making. It took him four months to plan and a year to build. He has a vast collection of photographs which he took to help him to get all the aspects correct. Every detail is as accurate as possible and it is wonderful to see the detail of the internal building as well as the painted stonework of the exterior. The pleasure and satisfaction which he feels for his work is matched by the interest and joy of everyone who views the model.
