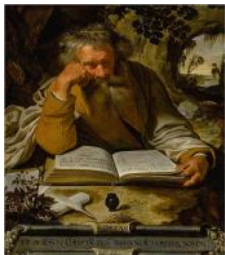

**Saint Andrew's Day** is the feast day of Andrew the Apostle. It is celebrated on 30 November. Saint Andrew's Day is Scotland's official national day. It has been a national holiday in Romania since 2015. Saint Andrew is the disciple in the New Testament who introduced his brother, the Apostle Peter, to Jesus as the Messiah. He is the patron saint of Cyprus, Scotland, Greece, Romania, Russia, Ukraine, the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, San Andres Island (Colombia), Saint Andrew (Barbados) and Tenerife.

**Hugh Owen**, St Faith's Electoral Roll Officer, is a Mancunian by birth but 'migrated' south via Luton and London. After Luton Grammar School he studied Spanish with French at King's London, also taking their broad-based course on religious subjects which gained him an AKC (Associate of King's College). He went to Manchester to take his PGCE (Post Graduate Certificate in Education) in primary education but then ended up teaching



Spanish at the William Fletcher School in Bognor Regis. After a short period as a language lecturer at Chichester College of Technology he changed his career completely. He was employed by Edward James of West Dean as his private secretary for six months travelling to Portugal and the Channel Islands. When the time came for him to move on, he returned to London working first as an administrator at University College and then at the City of London Polytechnic where he became their first examinations officer. Then, in 1984 he moved to Havant. Here he worked as an office manager and then as a self-employed management consultant, retiring in 2000. Currently he is attempting to draw a map of the St Faith's graves in New Lane Cemetery, having transcribed the related burial registers which are now online. Much time is consumed with family history research for himself and others. As a relaxation he enjoys reading crime novels - and he doesn't 'do' sport!

**Remembrance Sunday—8 November.** This year, because of COVID-19, the



Remembrance Sunday service will be different with no Civic Service at the War Memorial. There will be an *'invitation only'* event inside the church. Wreaths will be laid the 2 minutes silence will be observed, with bugler, inside the church. Wreaths will then be transferred to the outside war memorial at the end of the church service. The service will be live-streamed.

**Corporal David O'Connor.** On every Remembrance Sunday since 2013, this cross



made from shell cartridges by Royal Marine colleagues of *Corporal David O'Connor* of 40 Commando Royal Marines, is displayed on the High Altar. *David* was killed in Afghanistan on 24 October 2012 and his funeral was held in St. Faith's on 15 November 2012. *David's* mother *Rosemary* gave the cross to St. Faith's and she proudly wears the Elizabeth Cross which is a commemorative emblem given to the recognised next of kin of members of the British Armed Forces killed in action or as a result of a terrorist attack after the Second World

**Captain John Philip Blake MC.** There is an inscription at the back of the lectern "*In*
